- Maintain a procedure book (traditional or electronic)

- Become knowledgeable about the volunteer guidelines set by the school district
- Survey teachers and staff regarding volunteer needs in the school
- Survey potential volunteers to learn about their talents, interests and skills
- Hold volunteer orientation meeting
- Set goals for volunteers for the school year
- Recruit volunteers throughout the year
- Recognize volunteers for their hard work
- Evaluate volunteer program success after each event
- Review and become familiar with bylaws and standing rules of the PTA
- Attend Texas PTA Leader Orientation
- Take advantage of training from Council, Area and Texas PTA
- Become familiar with National and Texas PTA resources
